Carol Sutherland requests that all information be emailed to her by Wednesday, September 19th. Carol's email address is carolsutherland@satx.rr.com.

ALL: Review the draft budget information for your COG/region. If changes are needed, notify Carol Sutherland. Otherwise she will assume that you are fine with what was presented. Project descriptions should be 200 characters or less due to Investment Justification space restrictions. Changes must be submitted by 9/21/07. Prioritize your projects in the context of the SCIP and PSIC IJs.

Carol needs a half a page of data systems that are being utilized. John Chaney will provide Harris County information. One of the things that came out yesterday has we have a lot of voice interoperability but not much in data. There is a need to address where you are and a vision for data interoperability in the future. **Don McFarland, Robert Adelman, John Chaney, and Tom Sorley** will develop a standard format for data information.
